FOREWORD

Book thefts from libraries are a widespread problem that poses challenges for institutions worldwide. Libraries, known for their role in providing knowledge and cultural heritage, have been targeted by individuals seeking to exploit their resources.

Motivations behind book thefts can vary, ranging from financial gain to personal desire. Unfortunately, these thieves not only harm the libraries by impacting their finances and hindering their ability to serve patrons but also deprive future readers of access to stolen works.

The International League of Antiquarian Booksellers (ILAB) has recently established a Missing Books Register, an upgrade from a previous version, and this is available free of charge to anyone wishing to register an item as stolen or missing, whether from a library or a private collection.

It could also be useful for those contemplating a purchase, allowing a quick check to be made to make sure that the item has not been listed as lost or stolen. Although the site is dynamic, missing or stolen books can only be listed on the site if the loss is registered. ILAB's aim is to make it as comprehensive as possible by encouraging those impacted to register their loss.

The Register can be found at **www.missingbooksregister.org** and anyone can register free of charge to add a missing book to the register or see what has been reported as missing.

Associated items such as manuscripts, autographs, antique maps and prints can also be listed on the register and it is hoped that this might discourage future thefts.
