



FOREWORD

I can't let this moment pass without mentioning the Donald Trump win in the US Presidential elections.

The pundits, the polls and the always chattering media commentators all got it wrong, and whether you love or loathe Trump, you have to say that it was democracy at work, and the American people overwhelmingly chose him to be their President.
